

and creates opportunities for survivors to rebuild a sense of **control and empowerment**.






















Trauma and the Brain





Trauma "wears a groove" in the brain









Residents with views of nature have:

- Decreased mental fatigue
- Reduction in domestic violence and aggression
- Better performance on measures of attentional functioning
- Lower drug and crime rates
- Improved management of life issues and increased ability to cope
- Increase trust of neighbors and feeling of community, and
- Children have better concentration and self-regulation

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You have to let us know when your income or household size changes.

Why?

Because our funding requires it. When your income changes, your rent may need to change, too.

You must report your new income within 10 days or you may owe back rent. If you "fail to report" more than once, it can result in an eviction.

What to do:

Call or visit the office as soon as you know your income is going up or down or if your household size changes for any reason.

Report maintenance issues right away.

If anything in your home breaks or just isn't working like it should, we will fix it. Call the management office or submit an online maintenance request through your Rent Cafe resident portal.



We rely on you to let us know when something isn't right.

If you do not notify us and the issue continues or gets worse, you may have to contribute to the cost of fixing it.

If the problem involves a water leak, utility outage, or anything urgent, report the issue immediately - day or night.



Read your mail.

We do not mail you anything you do not need to read.

If you receive a letter from us, please read it.

Letters are one way we share important information like when inspections are happening, when we are doing building-wide maintenance, community events and opportunities, and much more.




Representation in the Autism Community



What is Autism?

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), is a complex, lifelong developmental condition that typically appears in early childhood and can impact a person's social skills, communication, relationships, and self-regulation.


- The Autism experience is different for everyone.

- Autism affects people differently and to varying degrees.

What it can actually look like:




Facts & Statistics

It is estimated that over 7 million individuals in the United States are on the Autism spectrum; Autism is the fastest growing developmental disability in the US.

- 1 in 36 children are diagnosed with autism by the age of 8.
- 86,000 individuals in Colorado have an I/ DD.
- Over the next decade 1 million
 Autistic teens will enter adulthood and age out of school-based services.





70% are also diagnosed with cooccuring diagnoses; ADHD, anxiety, depression

30%

of children are diagnosed with both autism and intellectual disability
